

Parents are advised of the following:

- One of our students on the Davisson Street Campus has been diagnosed with Swine Flu.
- The student was on Work Experience for 2 ½ weeks and returned to school on Thursday of this week.
- The student and his family are under quarantine but they are all well and the Department of Communicable Diseases are testing the family.
- Risk of this flu being passed on to anyone yesterday is extremely low (not impossible) but extremely low.
- Media outlets are now aware of this situation
- We have been reassured by the authorities that 'normal' flu is far more dangerous, however, if you are experiencing symptoms please take yourselves to the Doctor.
