Ambulance Officers

Ambulance Officers provide specialised transport services and emergency health care for injured, sick, infirm and aged persons.

Tasks

- Attends accidents, emergencies and requests for medical assistance and provides pre-hospital care
- Assesses health of patients, assesses need for assistance, specialised needs and factors affecting patients' conditions
- Performs therapies and administers drugs according to protocol
- Resuscitates and defibrillates patients and operates life-support equipment
- Transports accident victims/sick/disabled persons to medical facilities for specialised treatment
- Instructs community groups and essential service workers in first aid
- Attends public events where accidents and other health emergencies may occur
- Ensures that ambulances are adequately maintained and stocked with medical supplies, and that equipment is in good working order
- Prepares written reports on the state of patients' injuries and treatment

Commissioned Defence Force Officers provide high level management to support the running of organisational units within the Australian Defence Force.

Tasks

- Establishes administrative and operational procedures by taking account of the organisation's operating environment
- Makes policy decisions and accepts responsibility for operations, performance of staff, achievement of targets and adherence to budgets, standards and procedures
- Establishes lines of control and delegates responsibilities to subordinate staff
- Represents the organisation in dealings with other organisations and the public
- Controls the collection and interpretation of management information to monitor performance
- Controls the use of, and accounting for, the assets and facilities of the organisation
- Prepares budgets and other management plans
- Prepares reports, authorises the release of information, and handles public relations activities
